"Scotland Summer in Edinburgh" HIST 581/GENS 450 & HIST 435/ANTH 439

This course explores urban history, culture and film through close analysis of a global city: Edinburgh, Scotland's capital, UNESCO World Heritage City, and one of the most creative cities in the world! Program learning relies on dozens of field activities, including an overnight to Loch Ness and the Scottish Highlands, tours of Edinburgh Castle and the Royal Palace of Holyrood, ghost walks, Medieval churchyards, the Scottish Parliament, secret gardens, hidden villages, and the unbelievable Edinburgh Festival Fringe - the world's largest performing arts festival! Classrooms and housing are at the historic University of Edinburgh, right in the core of the ancient city. Weekends are your own to branch out and explore!

The Program fulfills 6 units of SDSU upper division GE credit (areas B and C) and satisfies study abroad requirements for 31 majors across campus.
